## **City-wide Wi-Fi Network Focus of Oct. 10 Clergy Meeting**

- **ACMN workshop will discuss Aurora's new Wi-Fi and the church.**

**Aurora, Ill. Sept. 28, 2006 (The Religion Wire™)** — The **Aurora Christian Ministry Network(ACMN)** and the Total Living Network(TLN) are inviting Aurora and Fox Valley area pastors and Christian leaders to the next **ACMN** meeting on **Tuesday, Oct. 10, 9 a.m., at the TLN headquarters**, 2880 Vision Court, Aurora.

The morning meeting's FREE workshop speaker will be **Ted Beck**, chief technical officer(CTO) for the City of Aurora. Beck's workshop topic will be "**What does the coming of city-wide wireless(Wi-Fi) Internet access mean for churches and congregations?**" with a Question/Answer time.

In mid-September the City of Aurora debuted its Wi-Fi network at the city's downtown Midwest Literary Festival. The hope is that this network would be city-wide by September 2007. The service is free, but will eventually be supported through banner ads at the top of the screen. Aurora points out that it was the first city in the state of Illinois to plan and announce such a network. The city is also creating a foundation to help low income families get laptops so they can take advantage of the network.

"I hope all Aurora church leaders and staff can come to TLN on Oct. 10 and take advantage of the opportunity to learn about Aurora's new communication tool, Wi-Fi, from the city's CTO Ted Beck," stress John Ross, facilitator for **ACMN**.
