### **Sept. 9 Rally Seeks Recruiters for Annual Fall Aurora Area CROP Walk** • October Walk Focuses on World and Local Hunger

**Aurora, Ill., Sept. 1, 2006** (*The Religion Wire*<sup>™</sup>) — Aurora area churches, schools, and other interested organizations are encouraged to send representatives to the **Sept 9 Aurora Area CROP Walk Recruiters' Rally**, 9 a.m., at Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd, 115 Oak St., North Aurora. The morning meeting's focus will be on walker recruitment for the **Oct. 15 hunger walk**.

The **Oct. 15 Aurora Area CROP Walk** begins at 1:15 p.m. with registration and a rally at Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd, 115 Oak St., North Aurora. At 2 p.m., the 10K walk will step-off.

Each year 25% of the monies raised by the annual fall hunger walk is distributed to local organizations involved in fighting hunger at the community level. The Aurora Area Interfaith Food Pantry and other area hunger-fighting organizations will share the walk's local contribution. Church World Service and other international agencies will use the remaining 75% for disaster relief and development around the world. This year's walk goal is \$15,000 and over 150 walkers. The Aurora community has held CROP Walks since 1974.
