WHEREAS, children represent the future of Aurora; and

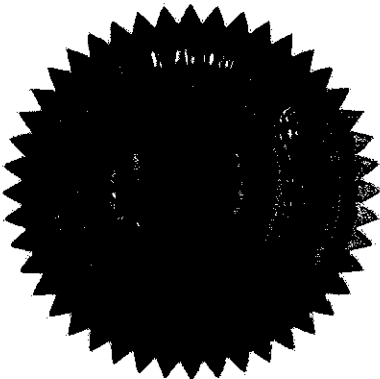
WHEREAS, it is especially important that the citizens of Aurora be aware of the needs of our children; and
