**“Celebrate Jesus Together”
Again, for the Fourth Year, Brings Churches to Aurora City Park
• August 15 Event at Aurora’s McCarty Park**

Aurora, Ill., August 6, 2010 (*The Religion Wire™*) — The public is invited to Aurora’s fourth annual city-wide worship gathering on **Sunday, Aug. 15, 4-5:30 p.m.**, at McCarty Park, Fourth St. at E. Galena Blvd. The event is titled **“Celebrate Jesus Together.”**

The gathering will present a city-wide gospel choir and combined Latino-soul-rockin’ worship. The audience will hear encouraging messages from several Aurora pastors. This is a cross-cultural and cross-racial event. English to Spanish translation will be provided.

The event’s rain site is the Harkness Family Center, 60 S. Fourth St.

“Again this year, as the last three years, *Celebrate Jesus Together* is a great opportunity for the local churches in Aurora to worship with each other. We want to show that we love each other, and honor the fact that God has placed a rich mosaic of ethnicities, worship styles, and giftings within the larger church of Aurora,” notes Randy Schoof, CJT chairperson, and pastor of Warehouse Church.

McCarty Park is located in the 400 block of East Galena Boulevard, two blocks east of Route 25 in Aurora. The park was renovated a couple of years ago by the City of Aurora and features a central fountain. Gathering participants are requested to bring a lawn chair or blanket.
